Applications called for Bali casualties

People directly affected by the Bali bombings in October are being urged to apply for financial assistance from the Lord Mayor's Distress Relief Fund.

Some payments have already been made under the first round of grants for West Australians who were hospitalised as a result of the terrorist incident and to next of kin of deceased. Assistance is available to Western Australians who suffered hardship as a result of the events in Bali.

The Appeal has now passed \$612,000 as a result of donations from the Australian Hotels Association and the Swan Brewery totalling more than \$63,000.

Applications are required before payments can be made. These will be considered on their merits on a case-by-case basis.
